

Young Investigator Award 2019

Guidelines:

During the Young Investigator Award session of the 22nd Practicum on Clinical Exercise Testing, three prizes will be awarded to outstanding research projects. Scientific abstracts from the field of clinical exercise testing may be submitted by researchers of age 36 and less. Work in progress may be submitted as well as published projects, however the work must have been published in 2018 or later. Earlier publications will not be considered.

From all submitted abstracts, a jury of faculty members will select the best five abstracts for presentation in the main auditorium on Friday, September 20th 2019. For all invited abstract presenters, the course fee will be waived. Should the finalists have already registered for the course before notification of the abstract results, the course fee will be refunded by CPX International. Travel costs and housing cannot be reimbursed.

After presentation of all five abstracts, the best three projects will be selected by the faculty based on originality of the work, scientific quality and quality of presentation. The presenter of the best abstract (first place) will be awarded €1000, the second place will be awarded €750, the third place will be awarded €500.

Please submit your abstract (max. 400 words, 1 figure, 1 table) and a short CV via E-Mail to czurda@mondial-congress.com. You will receive a confirmation of successful abstract submission.

The abstract submission deadline is Thursday September 12th 2019, 23:59 CET.

If the work has already been published, please also include an electronic copy (PDF) of the published article.
